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ORDER:

In the reference 3rd read above, the Commissioner, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad has reported that, recognizing the need for improvement of arterial routes, on the basis of Comprehensive Traffic Study taken up by HMDA, critical evaluation of the present levels of traffic loads and the congestion being experienced in Hyderabad, GHMC has evolved an Infrastructure Development Plan to include junction improvements with grade separators/flyovers, pedestrian oriented infra, tunnel corridors, storm water drainage projects etc., under H-CITI.

2. Further, he has reported that, the traffic management in the city is a pressing issue due to the huge commercial development in the past decade and needs to be addressed on priority basis. Thus, focusing on preventing traffic congestion and improving the overall traffic efficiency, GHMC has taken up the comprehensive traffic study based on which the following projects are proposed under H-CITI Project.

3. Further, he has reported that, earlier the Government vide G.O.Rt.No.892, MA&UD(GHMC.II) Department, dt.21.12.2022 and G.O.Rt.No.761, MA&UD(GHMC.II) Department, dt.27.09.2023, has accorded administrative sanction for below works at S.No.1, 4, 10 to 16, 19 to 21, 22 (a) & (b) and 23, but no budget was released to GHMC under Special Development Fund (SDF) and hence the works could not be taken up. Further, the above works along with certain new works are proposed under H-CITI project as follows:

3. Further, he has submitted that while grounding the SNDP works in GHMC, certain instructions were issued vide GO.Rt.No.157, MA&UD (GHMC-II) Dept. dt.09.03.2022 to avoid delay in completion of projects for want of shifting of utilities by the line departments. Because of this most of the SNDP works were completed in time. Hence, he has proposed to adopt the said GO in the H-CITI works also so that the utility shifting works will be taken up through the subsisting EPC agency duly adopting the following procedure:

- a. The respective utility Department will prepare estimate for shifting of utility.
- b. The EPC agency will execute the utility shifting under the supervision of utility department. Supervision charges @ 10% will be paid to TSSPDCL by GHMC and as HMWS & SB is a sister organization under MA & UD Department, no Supervision charges will be paid to them.
- c. Payment will be made to the EPC agency by GHMC, on the certification of the utility department.

4. Therefore, the Commissioner, GHMC has requested to Government (i) to accord administrative sanction for (23) works under Hyderabad City Innovative and Transformative Infrastructure (H-CITI) Project for an amount of **Rs.5942.00 Cr.** duly superseding the earlier sanction of Rs.4305.00 Cr accorded vide G.O.Rt.No.761 of MA&UD (GHMC II) Dept dt: 27.09.2023, (ii) expenditure to be met from the State budget allocated in every FY towards assistance to GHMC under H-CITI, (iii) to call tenders for Flyovers/ROB Projects under EPC method and to commence the works and carry out land/property acquisition, utility shifting etc., simultaneously with grounding of the project to save delay, (iv) to engage PMC agencies by calling separate tenders from the provisions made in the estimates for Supervision, Quality Control/Quality Assurance for all the works executed under EPC system and (v) to adopt G.O.Rt.No.157, MA&UD (GHMC-II) Dept. dt.09.03.2022 for shifting of utilities through the subsisting EPC Agency.

5. In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner, GHMC, Hyderabad and Government after careful examination of the matter hereby accord approval for the following;

- i. Administrative sanction for (23) works under Hyderabad City Innovative and Transformative Infrastructure (H-CITI) Project for an amount of **Rs.5942.00 Cr.** duly superseding the earlier sanction of Rs.4305.00 Cr accorded vide G.O.Rt.No.761 of MA&UD (GHMC II) Dept Dt: 27.09.2023.
- ii. Expenditure to be met from the State budget allocated in every FY towards assistance to GHMC under H-CITI.
- iii. To call tenders for Flyovers/ROB Projects under EPC method and to commence the works and carry out land/property acquisition, utility shifting etc., simultaneously with grounding of the project to save delay,
- iv. To engage PMC agencies by calling separate tenders from the provisions made in the estimates for Supervision, Quality Control/Quality Assurance for all the works executed under EPC system and
- v. To adopt G.O.Rt.No.157, MA&UD (GHMC-II) Dept. Dt.09.03.2022 for shifting of utilities through the subsisting EPC Agency.

6. The Commissioner, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action accordingly.
